

Kootenay Region Class II Classified Waters

NOTE: Streams in the noted areas are classified year-round and require an appropriate Classified Waters Angling Licence in addition to the basic Non-Tidal Angling Licence (see Exceptions).

Classified Waters Angling Licence required in this area (labelled "Kootenay River" for non-residents and non-resident aliens).

All National Park waters require a National Park Fishing Permit. Provincial angling licences NOT valid or required.

Classified Waters Angling Licence required in this area (labelled "Kootenay River" for non-residents and non-resident aliens).

Classified Waters Angling Licence required in this area (labelled "Elk River" for non-residents and non-resident aliens) (see Exceptions).

Classified Waters Angling Licence required in this area (labelled "White River" for non-residents and non-resident aliens).

EXCEPTIONS

The following waters DO NOT require a Classified Waters Angling Licence:

- All waters outside the noted portions of the map.
- All National Park waters (NOTE: Angling these waters requires a National Park Fishing Permit).
- All lakes, even if included in the watershed of a Classified Water.
- Coal Creek downstream of the old M.F. and M. Railway bridge located about 7 km upstream of Elk River.
