



**Walt Dette - Dry Fly Hackle Gauge & Streamer or Bucktail Gauge
Du Bois - Fly Fisherman's & Fly Tier's Gauge**

Publisher's Note: To preserve the gauges shown here, print them out and have them laminated!

WALT DETTE — DRY FLY HACKLE GAUGE

To use this gauge, the hackle should be measured at the point where it would be cut and tied to the hook. The feather is bent in a "U", and the stem held against the lower edge of this card with the fibers extending straight up toward the numbers. The line that the fiber tip touches is the hook size that the hackle should be tied on.

WALT DETTE — STREAMER OR BUCKTAIL GAUGE

Place the tips of the wing material, whether bucktail or streamer feather, even with the line that corresponds with the hook size to be used. Then cut the butts of the material even with the edge of this gauge.

Hook used — Mustad #3665A-6X long or similar
